


LAMU ISLAND - KENYA

■ The Red Pepper House, Lamu, Kenya
Imagine taking a trip back in time, to a place devoid of modern-day stresses and pressures.

A place where there are no roads, no cars, and the pace of life is reduced to the leisurely plodding of the donkeys which roam the beachfront carrying coconuts and spices, and where the people live off the sea in the same way their ancestors have done for generations before them.

This is the setting of Red-Pepper House, a luxurious collection of five Swahili 'Nyumbas' (houses) nestled on the beach

just down the coast from the historic Lamu Town, a settlement which has been declared a World Heritage Site on merit of its perfectly preserved architecture and culture, both of which are a mesmerising fusion of elaborate Arabic elegance and vivid Swahili colour.

The days can be spent lounging with your lady in the private sand-covered 'boma', or strolling down to the farthest points of the long stretch of beach. Pop the question over a magical, intimate seafood dinner under the stars or on a sunset cruise on Lamu's traditional

wooden dhows.

A mind-blowing day of snorkelling among dolphins and turtles is on the cards, and as well as cultural trips into Lamu town or just a day of lying on the beach watching the dhows sail by.
